- Can communicate needs, wants, & thoughts verbally
- Can listen to a story
- Can identify and write their name
- Can group like objects and form patterns
- Can count to 20 or higher
- Can follow two to three verbal directions
- Exhibits enthusiasm when trying new activities
- Can take turns and share
- Can sit still and pay attention
- Is able to use pencils, crayons, markers, and scissors
